

Connect Group Leaders FAQ

- **Why should I lead a Connect Group?**
 - Connect Groups have one, simple purpose—to bring people together. We believe God created us to live in community, and we believe life change happens in the context of meaningful and intentional relationships. As a leader - you get to be a part of making this happen!

- **What is the role of a Connect Group Leader?**
 - The primary role of a Connect Group leader is to help group members move one step in their walk with God. We want to help offer individuals a place to connect, a place to protect & a place to grow. God has a part for all of us to play in the church, and Connect Group leaders come alongside the pastors and staff of C3 to help care for people!

- **What are the expectations of a Connect Group Leader?**
 1. To be sincere, worthy of respect, and have a good reputation.
 2. To exemplify the highest moral commitment and maintain a disciplined life of Bible reading, prayer, fasting and tithing regularly at C3 Church.
 3. To be able to create positive group dynamics and deal with conflict resolution within the group.
 4. To have a genuine desire to serve and minister to other people. Must be able to lead, motivate, and teach other people.

- **What kinds of Groups can I lead?**
 - We follow the free-market approach which allows leaders to lead groups such as interest groups (hobbies and other special interests), Bible studies, book studies, recovery groups, financial/legacy groups, and freedom groups (Spring semester only). We encourage you to pray and pick a group that will help people move one step closer to God. If you need any help with your group, let us know!

- **What training is offered to me?**
 - As a Connect Group leader, you are never alone in creating community. We have a Connect Group team who are all committed to work alongside you to invest in having a great experience. We also have training for new leaders before the Fall Semester to help them start out prepared.
